Study Outline

Entry Requirements

You need to be aged 16 years or over at the start of the course and hold either 3 GCSE grades D, equivalent or above.

Equipment

You will need to have the required materials and equipment in order to successfully complete this qualification. We advise that you purchase the specialised kit with us, order forms are provided upon a successful interview.

Attendance

Part time; 3 hours per week on either a Tuesday or Wednesday evening for 34 weeks.

In the event of over subscription, additional courses may be added during the year.

Assessment

You will be assessed practically by bringing your own clients into college.

You will undertake five exams to underpin your theoretical knowledge and complete two assignments, whilst building up a Portfolio of evidence.

On successful completion of the course you will have the opportunity to become self-employed or work within a Nail Salon; or you might like to progress to either the full-time Beauty Level 2 qualification or
