What is an Apprenticeship?

Apprentices will be paid at least the national minimum apprenticeship wage, £3.70 per hour (April 2018), with many employers paying more.

You will work for at least 30 hours a week with your employer



Training for your qualification will take place either at your place of work or in College, usually for one day per week

Apprenticeships take between 1-5 years depending on the level, framework/standard, sector and your prior skills

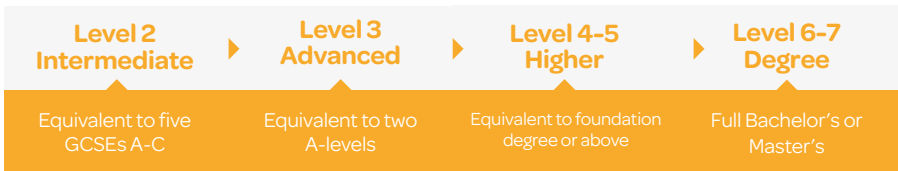
If you are 16 or over, already in employment and do not currently hold a qualification in your field you will be able to upskill through an Apprenticeship.
